Vehicle Requirements for Repair Assistance

- 1. Failed an emissions test within the past 30 days of the application date**
- 2. Currently registered in a participating county and has been for at least 12 months prior to the application date**
- 3. Passed the safety portion of the DPS motor vehicle safety and emissions inspection**
- 4. Vehicle must be drivable and gasoline-powered**

AirCheckTexas Drive a Clean Machine

Vehicle Requirements for Replacement Assistance

1. Currently registered in a participating county and has been for at least 12 months prior to the application date
2. Passed a DPS safety and emissions inspection within 15 months of the application date
3. Vehicle must be drivable and gasoline-powered

AND EITHER:

- 4a. Failed an emissions test within the past 30 days of the application date

OR

- 4b. At least ten years old or older

Additional Information for Repair or Replacement Assistance

- 1. Vehicle applying to program must be registered in vehicle owner's name (name on registration and title must be the same).**
- 2. A voucher must be presented to a listed participating repair facility or dealership at the time of the repair or purchase.**
- 3. No reimbursements to participants are allowed.**
- 4. No commercial or fleet vehicles are eligible for assistance.**
- 5. Note that the replacement vehicle value may affect eligibility for federal assistance programs, such as TANF, Food Stamps, etc.**
- 6. A cosigner on the replacement vehicle is allowed as long as the person lives in the same household as the AirCheck participant/vehicle owner and NCTCOG considered the cosigner's income when qualifying them for the program.**
